

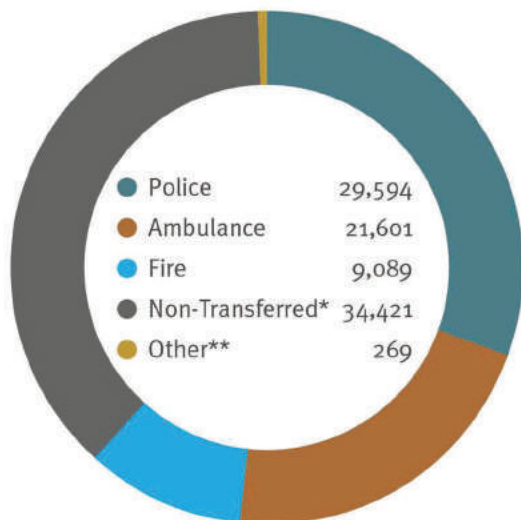
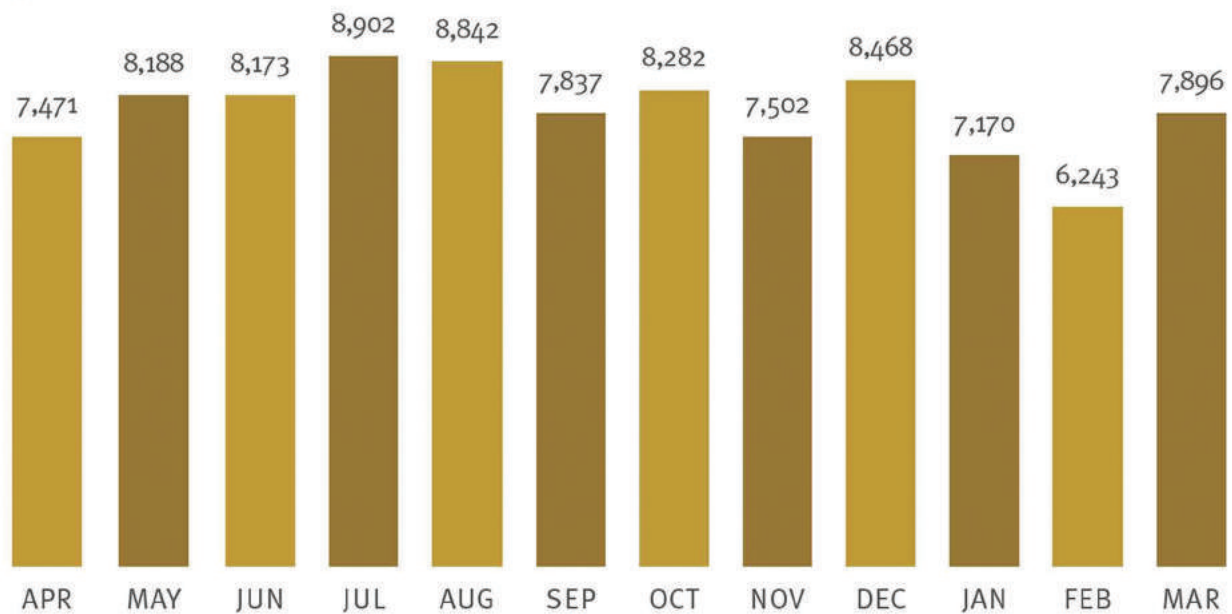
# STATISTICS

NL911 collects a variety of monthly data related to the usage of the emergency 911 telephone service in the province including, but not limited to, the volume and distribution of 911 calls. The following graphics show the 911 call volume for April 2016 to March 2017 and the distribution of total calls, over this same time period transferred to agency of priority.

Analysis of this and other data collected assists NL911 with identifying areas for better public education and awareness and supports the efficiency of the emergency response system as a whole.
